






AUTONOMY


Support the learner to own one's learning process

COMPETENCE

Support the learner to have the sense of accomplishment (structure)


RELATEDNESS

Support the learner to have the sense of "I belong", "I am not alone", and "someone cares" (involvement)

"What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything."


CONTEXT



Cognitive: How do I know what my students already know? How do I know which topic I need to clarify?




Affective: How do I know that the students are emotionally disposed/ready to explore new topic?
